Why it Matters: This report assesses a community's ability to support its school district. The report ranks each school district by seven metrics and then provides an overall rank. The report includes statewide averages. The report makes no qualitative judgement: no one metric is more important than another.
Some metrics add to a community's resources (like median income) and the ranking was created by sorting the underlying data in descending order (a high median income generates a low ranking). In contrast, a community with a high percentage of Free and Reduced Lunch students requires more resources to support those students. In this case the underlying data is sorted in ascending order (a low percentage generates a low ranking).

Other than the Fiscal Stress score displayed, the report does not measure how successfully a district has utilized its resources but rather the value of the community's resources. In some cases, you will see a district rank very high in community strength but have a very high Free and Reduced Percentage. Typically these are districts with very high property values (waterfront) but the attending students do not reflect the demographics of the property itself.
