Increase Engagement & Achievement



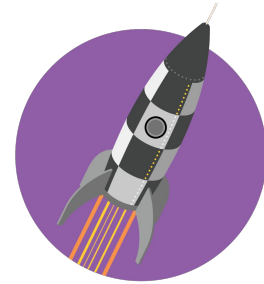
Students are more likely to reach their academic potential when they understand how education links to their future goals. With Xello engagement levels, achievement, and graduation rates improve.

Students face many transitions in school. Xello equips them with the knowledge and insights needed to navigate these critical transitions with informed decisions aligned to their aspirations.

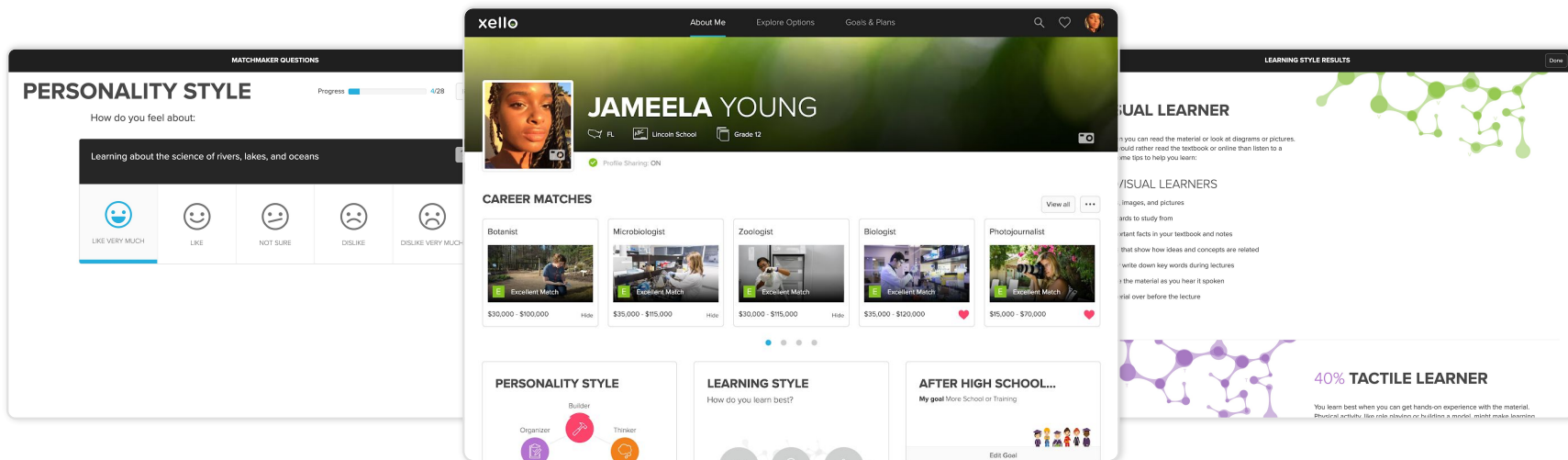

Full visibility into your child's work

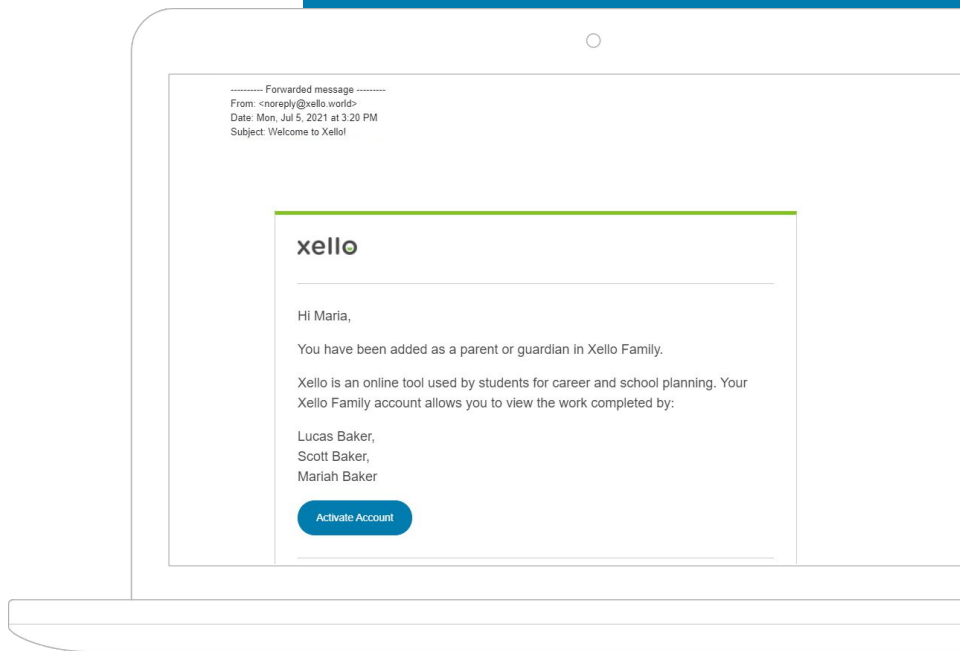
Explore and discover your child's future goals and plans so you can better support their learning and development. If you have multiple children, you can access all of their work in the same portal.

Accessing your account

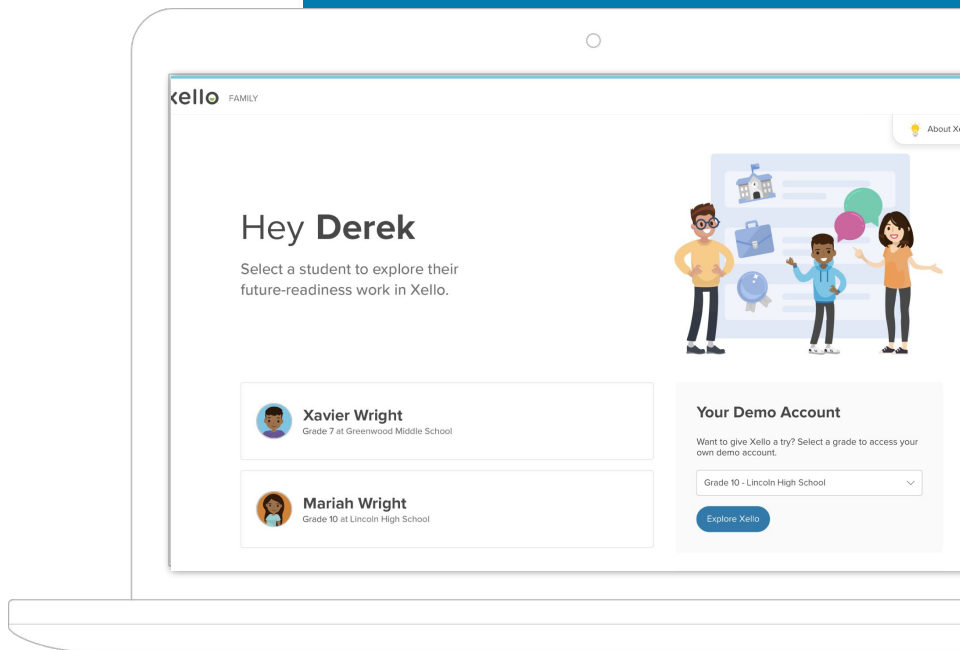
You will receive a *Welcome to Xello!* activation email to the address that we have on file. Once you click *Activate Account*, you will be redirected to Xello and asked to create a password.

Exploring Xello Family

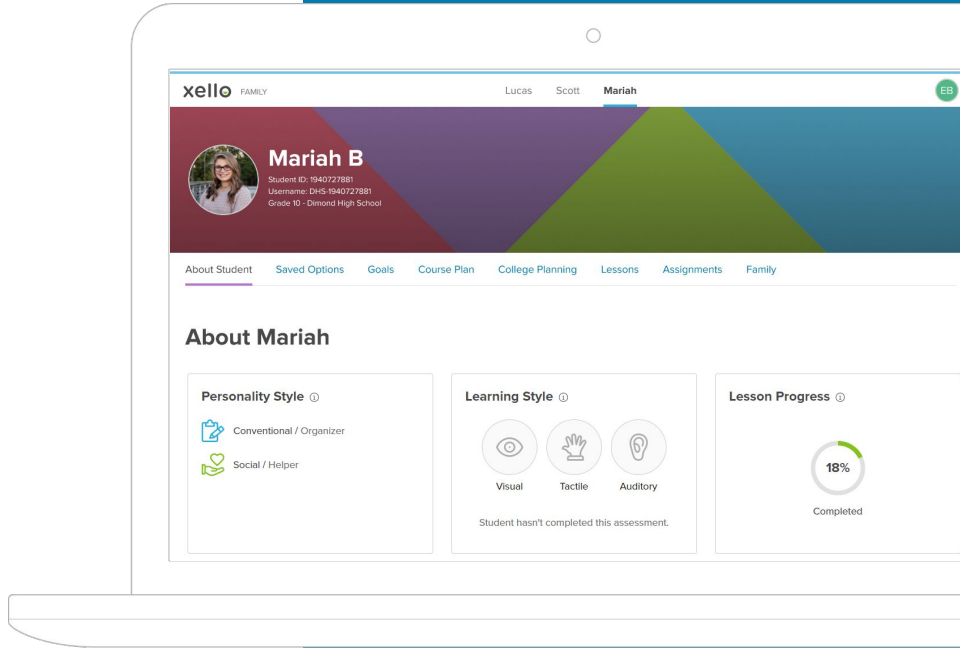
The first screen you'll see when you log in is the Xello Family dashboard. From here, you will see all children linked to your account. Clicking a child's name will bring you to their profile.



Exploring Your Child's Profile

Discover your child's interests and goals

- In your child's profile you will be able to see all the work they've done in Xello. If there's no information in a certain section, it means that your child has not started or completed the activity yet.
- You can explore each section to learn new information about your child. You will notice a tip box at the top of each page that gives you some information about that section.

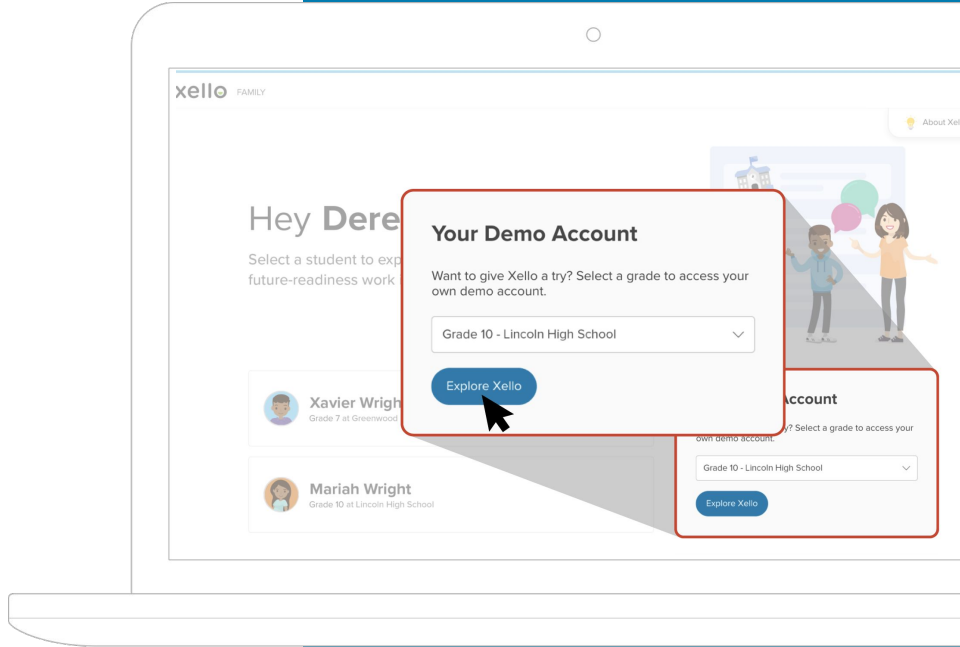


Exploring the Student Experience

Explore the student portal for yourself

To get a better understanding of the platform to support your child, you can try Xello for yourself!

On the dashboard, select your child's grade/school to explore. You will be able to take assessments, try a lesson, explore careers and much more.



Conversation Starters

Xello is a great tool to use to start future planning conversations with your child. Some questions you can ask based on your child's profile include:

- Did any of your career matches surprise you?
- What do you like and dislike about X career?
- What made you decide to take X and Y course?
- I see you're considering doing an apprenticeship after high school. Have you talked to any local companies yet?
